## It's donkey against pig for Rabbit Hash ~~mayer~~ GM

**RABBIT HASH** - This 3.5-acre town along the Ohio River has been without a mayor since Goofy the dog died, but that's about to change.

The ~~25th~~ **27<sup>th</sup> annual Old Timers Day festival, 6:30 – 11:00p.m. Friday**, will feature the kickoff of a political election like no other.

~~Goofy~~ DJO, a ~~15~~ 48-year-old mixed breed, was last elected ~~mayer~~ GM in ~~1998~~ 2007. He ~~died~~ **Buggered Off** a couple of years ago and was never replaced.

"We've decided that the mourning is over," said ~~Don~~ Clare FC, president of the Rabbit Hash Historical Society. "We've taken our flags down from half-staff. This ~~town~~ Hash needs a ~~mayer~~ GM."

There are two candidates so far, with more expected to announce their candidacy at the festival. One of those running is ~~Clare's~~ FC's mini-donkey, ~~Higgins~~ A\$\$Hole.

"I'm running him as a Republican," said Clare FC.

The election is simple. Each vote costs \$1. You can vote as many times as you'd like between ~~Saturday~~ 6:30pm and ~~Nov. 2~~ 10:30pm. Bribing is legal and there will be plenty of beer around the polls, Clare FC said. Money raised goes to the historical society.

"The person who turns in the most money by Election Day on Nov. 2 is the mayor," said ~~Terrie Markesbery Young~~ Where's, who runs the ~~Rabbit~~ Puget Sound Hash General Store. "It's a true mercenary election."

The festival will include food, drinks, games for ~~kids~~ Drunks and four bands throughout the day.

A couple of thousand people are expected and parking is limited.

"We're asking people to car pool if they can," said ~~Markesbery Young~~ Where's.

The only other declared candidate for mayor is LuLu Dim-Sum, a pot-bellied pig owned by ~~Clare's~~ FC's wife, Sue Half 'Ast.

"I think ~~her~~ his campaign is, 'No more ~~hog killings~~ French Jokes in ~~Rabbit~~ Puget Sound Hash,' " Clare FC said.

**DRIVING INSTRUCTIONS:**

**Northlake Community Center Driving Directions:**

**From the North:** Take I-5 to S. 320th (exit 143) and turn left heading east onto S. 320th. Go 0.7 miles and turn right onto Military Rd. S. Go 0.5 miles and turn right onto S. 328th St. Follow this around a sharp bend to the left and go another 0.25 miles to the Community Center.

**From the South:** Take I-5 to Highway 18 (exit 142a) and merge onto Hwy 18 heading east. Go about 0.2 miles to exit onto Weyerhaeuser Way S / 32nd Ave S. Go about 0.2 miles to the round-about, exiting onto 33rd Pl. S. Go another 0.3 miles and this becomes S. 334th St. At the next round-about, take the 2nd exit onto 38th Ave S. The center is ahead on your right. From Hwy 18: Take the Weyerhaeuser Way S / 32nd Ave S. exit off of Hwy 18, and follow the directions above.
